India withdraws bid to host climate summit in 2028

- India has withdrawn its bid to host the 33rd Conference of Parties (COP33) in 2028.

- COP is annual climate summit under United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC).
- India intent to host COP33 announced at COP28 in Dubai in 2023.
- Withdrawal communicated via letter dated April 2, 2026 by Rajat Agrawal, Joint Secretary, Ministry of Environment Forest and Climate Change.
- Ministry earlier created special cell in July 2025 for COP33 preparation.
- India candidature supported internationally including BRICS Summit declaration July 7, 2025.
- COP hosting rotational basis among UN regional groups.
- India belongs to Asia Pacific group.
- COP30 hosted by Brazil.
- COP31 (2026) jointly hosted by Turkiye and Australia.
- COP32 (2027) scheduled in Ethiopia.
- South Korea currently only country interested in hosting COP33.
- India previously hosted COP8 in 2002.
- India updated Nationally Determined Contributions targets include:
 - 60% electricity capacity from non fossil fuel sources by 2035
 - Reduce emissions intensity of GDP by 47% by 2035 (from 2005 level)
 - Create additional carbon sink of 3.5 to 4 billion tonnes CO2 equivalent by 2035

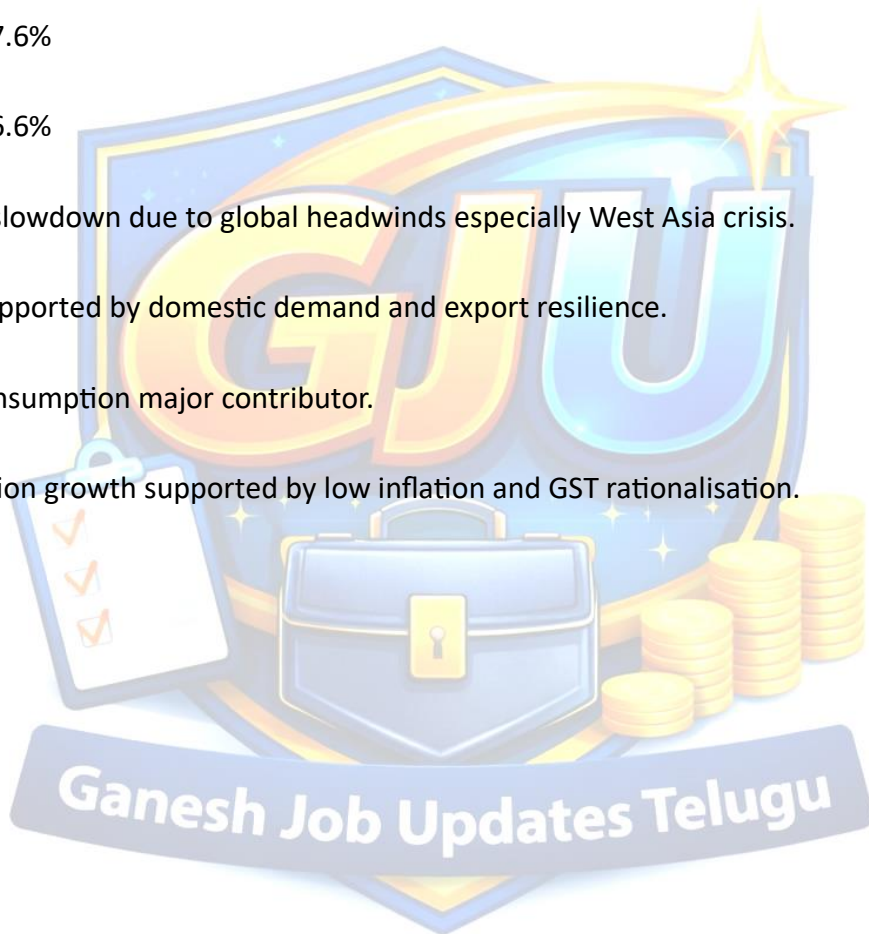
World Bank raises India growth forecast by 30 bps to 6.6% for FY27

- World Bank raised India GDP growth forecast for FY2027 to 6.6%.
- Increase of 30 basis points from previous estimate.
- Projection mentioned in South Asia Economic Update report.

India growth trajectory:

- FY2025 – 7.1%
- FY2026 – 7.6%
- FY2027 – 6.6%
- Expected slowdown due to global headwinds especially West Asia crisis.
- Growth supported by domestic demand and export resilience.
- Private consumption major contributor.
- Consumption growth supported by low inflation and GST rationalisation.
